For Post Graduate Entrance Examination of IOM and it's Affiliated Colleges

### For Nepalese and Foreign applicants

This is the notice for admission in the Institute of Medicine and its affiliated colleges for all postgraduate Program for the academic year 2019 (2075/076) Application is called from all qualified Nepalese and Foreign candidates for the program.

Nepalese candidates must insert the voucher number (Transaction Number), date of issue of the voucher and branch name of the bank at the bottom of the page of 'Instruction to applicant for filling up the online application form in order to open the 'Application Form'. In order to submit the application a scanned copy of the bank voucher must be uploaded on the application form. Please make sure the voucher number is legible (when filled in by the bank staff) before scanning it and uploading it. The applicants must follow the instructions and fill in the form and upload the documents as asked. The application fee once submitted will not be refunded under any circumstance.

Foreign candidates must fill in the "Foreign Category" online application form. It is not necessary for foreign candidates to upload the bank voucher in the application form. However, a copy of the original bank voucher must be submitted at the time of collecting the Admission Card from the Department of Information Technology, IOM Maharajgunj, Kathmandu from 27<sup>th</sup> March to 29<sup>th</sup> March 2019. Admission card will only be issued after proper verification (Passport or 'Adhar' card) of the candidate.

To correct in an already submitted form, apply in Examination Control Division with a voucher of NPR 500 (Five hundred) deposited in the above mentioned bank details on 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2019 before 4:00 PM.

#### Entrance examination date & time (For all programmes)

- 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2019 Saturday 10:00 am to 12:00 am (MD/MS, MDS, MN, M.Sc.Cl. Microbiology, M.Sc.Cl. Biochemistry, MSc.MIT, MD Ayurveda (Kayachikitsa) & MPhil Cl. Psychology)
- Examination for MPH/MPHN/MHPE will be notified later.
- Name of the centers will be uploaded later on.

Nepalese and Foreign Candidates will take the same entrance examination. All examinations will have multiple-choice questions with full mark of 100 (one hundred) and one appropriate answer. The duration of the examination will be 2 (two) hours. Minimum pass mark is 50% and there is no negative marking.



## GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PG PROGRAM

### Selection for admission

- A common entrance examination will be conducted for both Nepalese and Foreign Candidates.
- Merit list for Nepalese and Foreign Candidates will be published separately.
- Only name and roll number of the candidates who will secure a minimum of 50% marks will appear in the merit list
- Admission will be conducted on merit basis by 'open house' counseling/online counseling for constituent and affiliated campus/colleges, details will be uploaded later.

### Academic/ Administrative rules and regulations for PG Students/Residents

- Academic session begins: 24<sup>th</sup> April, 2019.
- Postgraduate students will go through a full time residential training wherever applicable.
- It is obligatory to obey and follow the rules and regulations of IOM.
- Not more than two weeks leave is allowed in one academic year for hospital based clinical/para-clinical program (MD/MS, MDS and MD Kayachikitsa).
- Holidays and vacation for all other Postgraduate program will be according to Tribhuvan University, Institute of Medicine regulation.
- All Post graduate programs are strictly non-practicing; therefore all PG Students/Residents are prohibited to undertake private practice of any kind or any other private assignment during their entire course.
- As per curriculum requirement all candidates during their study of the Postgraduate program (MD/MS, MDS and MD kayachikitsa) will have three months community based teaching/Learning at assigned hospitals.
- As per circular of the Ministry of Health, Government of Nepal:
  - Nepalese candidates must have a minimum of 1 year work experience in any hospital recognized by Ministry of Health after completion of internship to become eligible for government scholarship & nomination.
  - All Postgraduate Nepalese PG students under scholarship scheme will have to sign a bond with Government of Nepal, Ministry of Health after successful completion of their course and will have to serve for five year in the hospitals assigned by Ministry of Health.
- Students can be expelled from his/her course any time during the study period on recommendation of the department head in following circumstances:
  - Academic performance is found unsatisfactory
  - Faces criminal charges,
  - Found involved in forgery,
  - Faces disciplinary action,
  - Remains absent for more than 15 days without any valid reason.
